- Are you a small to medium sized, London based charity, seeking to offer opportunities to staff and volunteers for personal development?
- Are you working for a homelessness charity and interested in free individual coaching and building team resilience?
- Would you like to take part in weekly sessions of personal development from October 2021 to March 2022?



What is it?

- On **5th July** applications open to the **Responding to Resilience Risk 2 (RRR2)** programme.
- This programme of **personal and team development** is devised by Guildhall Coaching Associates and initiated and funded by City Bridge Trust with Oak Foundation.
- The programme will run from **October 2021- March 2022**. Coaching principles underpin this resilience training, which will be delivered via group and one to one sessions.

What does it involve?

- Each organisation participating will receive a payment of **£25,000** (inclusive) to enable staff time to be released for programme focus.
- Individuals taking part will commit to the programme as a whole, incorporating **one to one and group activities led by specially trained coaches** from Guildhall Coaching Associates.
- Participants will be part of research and an evaluation, **led by our partner Renaishi**, alongside sessions to enable understanding the impact of resilience-based initiatives.

Who can apply?

- **Twelve organisations** whose primary focus is homelessness will be selected to take part, each with **eight individual staff members or long-term volunteers** who are able to commit on average three hours per week to the programme, with this time protected by the organisation in question. All organisations **must work towards a charitable objective** and have an **up to date safeguarding policy in place**.
- Only **London based organisations are eligible**, with any staff or volunteers involved having a London focus to their work.
- **Participants must work as part of the team to deliver frontline services** for the organisation applying. Staff from a **range of roles and seniority** are encouraged to participate.
- Micro, small and medium organisations with an annual **turnover not significantly over £2million** are welcome to apply.
